

96 Bodega Piedra Negra Chacayes Los Chacayes 2015 \$99 ARGENTINA Very elegant and rich, with concentrated kirsch, dark plum and cherry tart flavors, backed by medium-grained tannins and fresh acidity. Shows grip midpalate, leading to a finish that turns creamy and plush, primed with spicy richness and chocolate mousse accents. Malbec and Cabernet Sauvignon. Drink now through 2027. 3,000 cases made.—K.M.



Spring Mountain Vineyard Elivette Napa Valley 2016 \$160 CALIFORNIA Lush boysenberry, blackberry and plum fruit cascades forth, backed by streaks of charcoal, dark tobacco and roasted apple wood on the finish. Shows heft as well as mouthwatering cut, with a buried iron note resonating through the finish. Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, Merlot and Malbec. Best from 2023 through 2040. 2,400 cases made.—J.M.



Wet stone notes show midpalate, leading to a finish that lingers with light buttery details and rich spiciness. Drink now through 2026. 357



95 Beaux Frères Pinot Noir Ribbon Ridge The Beaux Frères Vineyard 2018 \$95 OREGON A wine of presence and expression, impeccably structured yet elegantly layered, with evocative raspberry, rose petal and brown baking spice notes that pick up richness and tension toward fine-grained tannins. Drink now through 2029. 3,088 cases made.—T.F.



Caprili Brunello di Montalcino 2015 \$60 S Caprill Brunello of Floritations 2 STALY Offering cherry, plum, iron, earth and floral aromas and flavors, this is vibrant and beautifully balanced. Well-structured, with the harmony and concentration to develop. Best from 2023 through 2043. 4,000 cases made, 3,000 cases imported.—B.S.





Medium-bodied and elegant, with minerally grip adding to the structure and complexity. Saffron notes linger on the long, mouthwatering finish. Best from 2022 through 2035. 154 cases imported.—A.Z.




Ciacci Piccolomini d'Aragona Brunello di 94 Ciacci Piccolomilia d Alagoria

Tightly wound and energetic, with fine balance and a lingering, resonant aftertaste. Complex and built to age. Best from 2023 through 2042. 6,208 cases made, 2,500 cases imported.—B.S.




Dry Creek Zinfandel Dry Creek Valley Spencer's Hill Vineyard Single Vineyard Series 2016 \$44 CALIFORNIA A knockout example of Dry Creek Zin, this is briary yet polished and refined, with lively raspberry, grilled anise and cracked pepper flavors that build power and tension toward broad-shouldered tannins. Drink now through 2030. 800 cases made.—T.F.




Mount Veeder Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley 2016 \$44 CALIFORNIA This displays a pure core of black cherry, cassis and plum puree flavors before the back end clamps down, revealing grippy tar and apple wood notes. Shows freshness and drive, with a pervasive sagebrush detail. Needs time to round into form. Best from 2022 through 2038. 39,041 cases made.—J.M.



The Seeker Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough 2019 \$14 NEW ZEALAND Lime, white grapefruit and white pepper flavors are fresh and bright, leaning into Key lime notes on the mouthwatering, intense finish. Drink now. 22,000 cases made, 22,000 cases imported.—M.W.



Kenwood Chardonnay Monterey-Sonoma Renwood Charactering Fruity, with Counties 2018 \$12 CALIFORNIA Fruity, with melon and crisp Gala apple flavors that are filled with light spice, cream and honey notes. Hints of dried shiso leaf show on the finish. Drink now. 59,000 cases made.—K.M.



Oxford Landing Cabernet Sauvignon 86 South Australia 2017 \$10 AUSTRALIA This is dense, with notes of toffee and espresso complementing the blackberry and cassis flavors. Toasted herb and tobacco elements linger on the finish, where the tannins firm up. Drink now. 55,000 cases made, 5,000 cases imported.—M.W.

89 TriVento Malbec Luján de Cuyo Golden Reserve 2017 \$21 Crisp and fresh-tasting, with cherry, licorice and brambly flavors, accented by flinty notes. The peppery finish shows smoky details. Drink now through 2023. 55,000 cases made, 11,000 cases imported.—K.M.

88 Vinaceous Chardonnay Margaret River Reverend V 2018 \$23 The apple, citrus and pear flavors show an appealing richness, with spice and dried floral hints on the finish. Drink now. 500 cases made, 150 cases imported.—M.W.

87 Bulletin Place Moscato South Eastern Australia NV \$11 Sweet candied apple, pear and peach flavors are tangy and juicy in this version, with fizzy bubbles, a floral detail and fresh acidity. Drink now. 1,000 cases imported.—M.W.

87 The Chook Sparkling Shiraz South Australia NV \$23 Robust, with black cherry, star anise and strong black tea flavors that lean into notes of sandalwood and mahogany, with a spicy, fizzy finish. Drink now. 5,000 cases made, 1,400 cases imported.—M.W.

93 Alzinger Riesling Smaragd Wachau Ried Hollerin 2018 \$49 This is expressive and suave, with some body, showing slight grip midpalate. Features notes of white raspberry, bergamot and lavender. Firmly structured, exhibiting great complexity and a long, mouthwatering finish. Beautifully balanced and focused overall. Best from 2021 through 2030. 157 cases imported.—A.Z.

93 Hiedler Riesling Kamptal Ried Heiligenstein Reserve 2018 \$53 A glossy white, featuring notes of nectarine, persimmon and honeysuckle, underscored by a crunchy texture and vibrant acidity. Exhibits great balance and length, with well-rounded edges and no sharpness whatsoever. This will probably show more with a few years of age, but remains approachable now. Drink now through 2030. 125 cases imported.—A.Z.

92 Prieler Pinot Blanc Leithaberg 2017 \$42 A beautiful white that combines richness with elegance, featuring notes of jasmine and elderflower that frame the core of white peach and yellow apple flavors. Shows a firm backbone, built from chalky minerality and well-integrated acidity. White pepper and wet stone details emerge on the prolonged finish. Drink now through 2027. 116 cases imported.—A.Z.

90 Der Pollerhof Niederösterreich Vom Löss 2018 \$25 Offers aromas of orchard blossom and freshly cut melon, while the palate features flavors of apricot, papaya and white pepper. Lively and expressive, with a finish that lingers and invites you back for another sip. Sauvignon Blanc, Gelber Muskateller and Traminer. Drink now. 50 cases imported.—A.Z.

89 Schmelzer Zweigelt Burgenland 2015 \$25 Finely extracted, this features firm tannins and good flavor intensity, with dark mulberry, blackberry and wild berry tea notes. Lively, showing ample complexity, this red can be enjoyed on its own but would be better with food. Drink now through 2024. 100 cases imported.—A.Z.

88 Glatzer Zweigelt Carnuntum Rebencuvée 2018 \$17 Notes of candied cherry and violet mark this light- to medium-bodied red. Round and well-balanced, with good vibrancy. Shows a subtle spice accent on the moderate finish. Drink now. 195 cases imported.—A.Z.
